**Course aim:**

- provide a study framework to ensure students with the basics of sociological knowledge of the family institution, the trends of marriage and family relations, goals and strategies of family policy, methodology and methods of sociological study of family and marriage, the concept of family as a social system, its structure, functioning and development, the basis of modern family Ukrainian policy.
- enhance the students' skills in the production of practical experience in the development and application tools and teaching facilities. The specifics of this discipline lies in the fact that its study can serve as a basis for personal growth and the growth of its own competence in the field of marriage and family relations.
