believe in yourself	to have confidence that you can be successful
have a natural talent	to be born with a particular ability or skill
be world-class at	to be one of the best people in the world at what you do
master	to learn a subject or skill very well
craft	a skilled activity in which you make something using your hands
skill	an ability to do something well, especially because you have learned and practised it
focus on	to give special attention to one particular person or thing
award	a prize for being more successful or popular than other people or things
shortlist	a list of people and things that have been chosen from a larger group
runner up	to be considered for a job or prize
winning team	the person or team that finishes second in a competition
nominate	the group that wins a competition
get an 'A'	to officially suggest that sb or sth should be given an important position or prize
have one thing in common	to achieve the highest mark that a student can get in an examination or for a piece of work
have access to	to share an interest or idea with someone
be world-class at	to have the right to enter a place, use something, see someone, etc.
pick up on	to be one of the best people in the world at what you do
put sth in	to show or notice something that other people have not noticed
have a talent for	to spend time or use energy working or practising something
agree with	to have an unusual amount of skill in a particular area
argue with	to have the same opinion as someone else
worry about	to shout and say angry things to someone because you disagree with them
complain about	to keep thinking about a problem or about something bad that might happen
belong to	so that you do not feel happy or relaxed
pay attention to	to say that you are annoyed, not satisfied, or unhappy about something or someone
wait for	if something belongs to someone, they own it
	to listen to or watch someone or something carefully
	to stay somewhere or not do something until something else happens or someone arrives

pay for	to give someone money for something you buy or for a service
depend on	if something depends on something else, it is directly affected by that thing
rely on	to trust or depend on someone or something
look at	to turn your eyes towards something, so that you can see it
laugh at	to make sounds with your voice because you think something is funny
succeed in	to do what you tried or wanted to do
believe in	to think that something is true or that someone is telling the truth
cope with	to succeed in dealing with a difficult problem or situation
write about	to produce a new book, article, poem etc
part with	to give or sell something to someone, although you do not want to
stick to	to do what you said you would do, even when it is difficult
care for	to look after someone or something
protest about	to show publicly that you think something is wrong
lead to	to cause something to happen or cause someone to do something
work for	to do a job that you are paid for
work on	to spend time working in order to produce or repair something
go on	to continue
take part in	to participate
result in	to make something happen
have a lot of ability as	to be (very) skilled
have an aptitude for	to have a natural ability
hopeless at	having no ability
be an expert in	to have a special skill or special knowledge of a subject, gained as a result of training or experience
be gifted at	to have a natural ability
skilful	good at doing something that you have learned and practised
talented	having a natural ability to do something well
useless at	not useful or effective at all
qualification	if you have a qualification, you have passed an examination or course to show you have a particular level of skill or knowledge in a subject
certificate	an official document that shows something is true or correct
driving licence	an official card that says that you are legally allowed to drive a car

licence	an official document that gives you permission to do or own something
distance learning	a method of study that involves working at home and sending your work to your teacher
apprenticeship	the job of being an apprentice, or the period of time in which you are an apprentice
face-to-face	a face-to-face meeting, conversation, etc. is one where you are with another person
