Art Nouveau is an international style of art, architecture, and applied art that was
most popular between 1890 and 1910. It was inspired by natural forms and
structures, not only in flowers and plants but also in(1).
Architects tried to harmonize with the natural environment. Art Nouveau is
considered a "total" art style, embracing architecture, graphic art, interior design,
and most of the decorative arts including jewelry, furniture, textiles, household
silver, and other utensils, and lighting, as well as the fine arts. According to the
philosophy of the style, art should be a way of life. Art Nouveau designs often use
long,(2), organic lines, frequently depicting flowers, plants, or
other nature-inspired motives. The movement was committed to

liberal arts, such as painting and sculpture, as superior to craft-based decorative arts;
