Syntactic functions of the Infinitive

1. Subject

To live means to cognize

It is important to discuss this issue. (formal subject)

2. predicative

My intention is to win in the game.
They seemed to have been living there all their life.

- 3. part of a compound verbal predicate
 - a) after modal verbs and expressions expressing modality

We **must work** hard.

She could have done it better.

I intended to go to the interview.

I intended to have gone to the interview

- b) after the verbs denoting beginning, duration and finishing of the action (aspect verbs) She continued to tell the story.
- 4. object

She asked him to come in time.

He has learn't to drive.

I like it when it rains. (introductory object it)

He found it difficult to come in time. (introductory object it)

5.part of a complex object

I saw him come into the office.

6. attribute

I haven't had enough time to do it.

She is a nice girl to talk to .

He has a child to take care of . (modal significance)

It was time to start a new life. (shade of purpose)

- 7. adverbial modifier
 - a) of purpose: He opened the window to breath some fresh air.

He came to the meeting in order to clarify some questions

She called him so as to know he was fine.

b) of result: He was too busy to help me.

He was so kind as to give his house at our disposal for the whole day.

- c) comparison (manner): She waved as if to stop him from coming closer (additional shade of purpose)
- d) attendant circumstances: She left never to come back again.
- 8. parenthesis: *To cut a long story short,* that was a nice day

He was arrogant, to say the least of it

To put it mildly, he is not the best guy

To speak the truth, I liked it very much.
