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1. Description of the academic discipline

Study of the discipline "Constitutional Law" contributes to the development of the general professional culture of any specialist in the field of law and is quite important for the practical implementation of the theoretical knowledge obtained. Firstly, for those students who are preparing for service in law enforcement agencies, state authorities and local self-government, and secondly, in connection with the need for a comparative legal analysis of domestic and foreign institutions of constitutional law in order to take into account the positive experience of countries with developed democracies and implement positive achievements in the domestic practice of state-building on the way to building Ukraine as a democratic, independent, social, legal state.

At the same time, the academic discipline has great cognitive significance, since the knowledge gained will contribute to the formation of democratic views and modern legal awareness of citizens of our state. After all, many constitutional and legal institutions that are introduced today in Ukraine first arose in the constitutional law of foreign countries (constitutions, parliamentarism, separation of powers), and only then did they receive them into the constitutional and legal space of our state, and therefore understanding their genesis, modern development prospects is a step towards resolving the urgent issues of statehood in Ukraine.

The current state of statehood in Ukraine, which has chosen a vector of foreign policy development aimed at European integration, requires a future lawyer to have, on the one hand, general, informational and worldview competencies, and, on the other hand, special professional competencies that are oriented or based on comparative legal material and involve knowledge and analysis of constitutional and legal legislation. That is why the study of constitutional law should provide students with the appropriate level of professional knowledge that can be implemented in the practice of statehood in our country.

In Ukraine, a specialist is traditionally considered an educated person with a broad worldview, the presence of thorough encyclopedic knowledge, practical skills for solving complex problems that arise in the process of professional activity. This is especially relevant in the context of the rapid globalization of the world community, when knowledge of national law is no longer enough to become a modern lawyer.

Studying the features of the development of constitutional law, analyzing national features of the form of the state, the relationship between the state and society, the organization and functioning of state authorities and local self-government bodies allows not only to broaden the horizons of students majoring in public management and administration, but also to understand the role of the state and the individual in the world.

The interactive format of the course, which will encourage debates, polemics, and the argumentative defense of one's own point of view, is focused on the development of critical skills for a modern specialist.
