## **John Baugh — The Significance of Linguistic Profiling**

### *Vocabulary focus*

- What does \*linguistic profiling\* mean, and how is it similar to \*racial profiling\*?
- Define \*speech variety\* and \*code-switching\*. How can they become social markers?

### *Discussion and reflection*

- What are the real-world consequences of judging someone by their accent?
- How does Baugh connect language to institutional power or inequality?
- Do you think people are aware when they engage in linguistic profiling?

## **Nethra Gopalakrishnan — Accentric (Accent Discrimination)**

### *Vocabulary focus*

- Explain \*accent discrimination\* and how it differs from \*linguistic prejudice\*.
- What does \*linguistic identity\* mean, and how can it be threatened?

### *Discussion and reflection*

- What emotions does the speaker associate with her accent?
- How does she describe society's perception of "native" and "non-native" English?
- How might accent discrimination affect someone's professional opportunities?

### *Vocabulary focus*

- Define \*assimilation\* and \*linguistic conformity\*.
- What does \*code-switching\* reveal about identity and belonging?

### *Discussion and reflection*

- What challenges does Safia face as a first-generation speaker?
- How does her experience illustrate hidden biases in education or media?
- What solutions does she suggest for overcoming prejudice toward accents?

## **Fahad Saeed — The Importance of Using Inclusive Language**

### *Vocabulary focus*

- Define \*inclusive language\* and \*microaggression\*.
- What is \*linguistic sensitivity\*, and how does it relate to respect?

### *Discussion and reflection*

- According to Saeed, how can word choice perpetuate stereotypes?
- What role does language play in shaping workplace culture?

- Which examples of inclusive vs. exclusive language stood out to you most?

## **Safwat Saleem — Why I Keep Speaking Up, Even When People Mock My Accent**

### *Vocabulary focus*

- Define \*mockery\* and \*resilience\* in the context of communication.
- What does \*linguistic authenticity\* mean to you?

### *Discussion and reflection*

- How does the speaker's stutter and accent become symbols of strength?
- What strategies does he use to challenge social expectations of "good speech"?
- Why is this talk a strong example of reclaiming one's linguistic identity?

## **Jamila Lyiscott — 3 Ways to Speak English**

### *Vocabulary focus*

- What is \*code-meshing\*, and how does Lyiscott use it in her performance?
- Define \*linguistic double consciousness\* — how can it describe her experience?

### *Discussion and reflection*

- What message does Lyiscott convey about "standard English" and power?
- How does her spoken-word style itself challenge linguistic prejudice?
- What emotions and identities coexist in her three "ways" of speaking English?

## **Chimamanda Ngozi Adichie — The Danger of a Single Story**

### *Vocabulary focus*

- Define \*stereotype\* and \*narrative bias\*.
- What does \*representation\* mean in the context of culture and language?

### *Discussion and reflection*

- How does Adichie connect storytelling to prejudice and misunderstanding?
- In what ways can language create or challenge stereotypes?
- What parallels can you draw between "a single story" and linguistic prejudice?

## **Anne Curzan — What Makes a Word "Real"?**

### *Vocabulary focus*

- Define \*prescriptivism\* and \*descriptivism\* in linguistics.
- What does \*lexical innovation\* mean?

### *Discussion and reflection*

- How does Curzan challenge the idea of "proper" English?
- What social power dynamics are hidden in language rules?
- Should dictionaries reflect usage or define standards? Why?

## **Lera Boroditsky — How Language Shapes the Way We Think**

### *Vocabulary focus*

- Define \*linguistic relativity\* and \*cognitive framing\*.
- What is \*grammatical gender\*, and how can it influence perception?

### *Discussion and reflection*

- What examples show how language influences thought?
- Do you agree that speakers of different languages “see” the world differently?
- How might linguistic diversity help combat prejudice?
