Knowledge, skills, values, beliefs, and habits of a group of people are transferred to other people, through storytelling, discussion, teaching, training, or research.



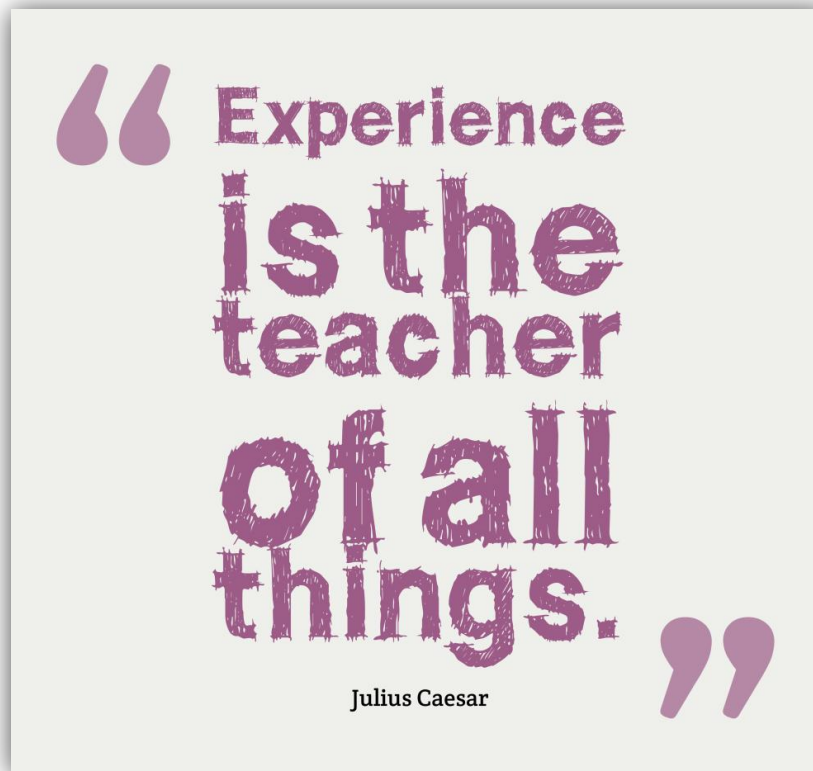
Autodidactic learning

Education frequently takes place under the guidance of educators, but learners may also educate themselves in a process called autodidactic learning.



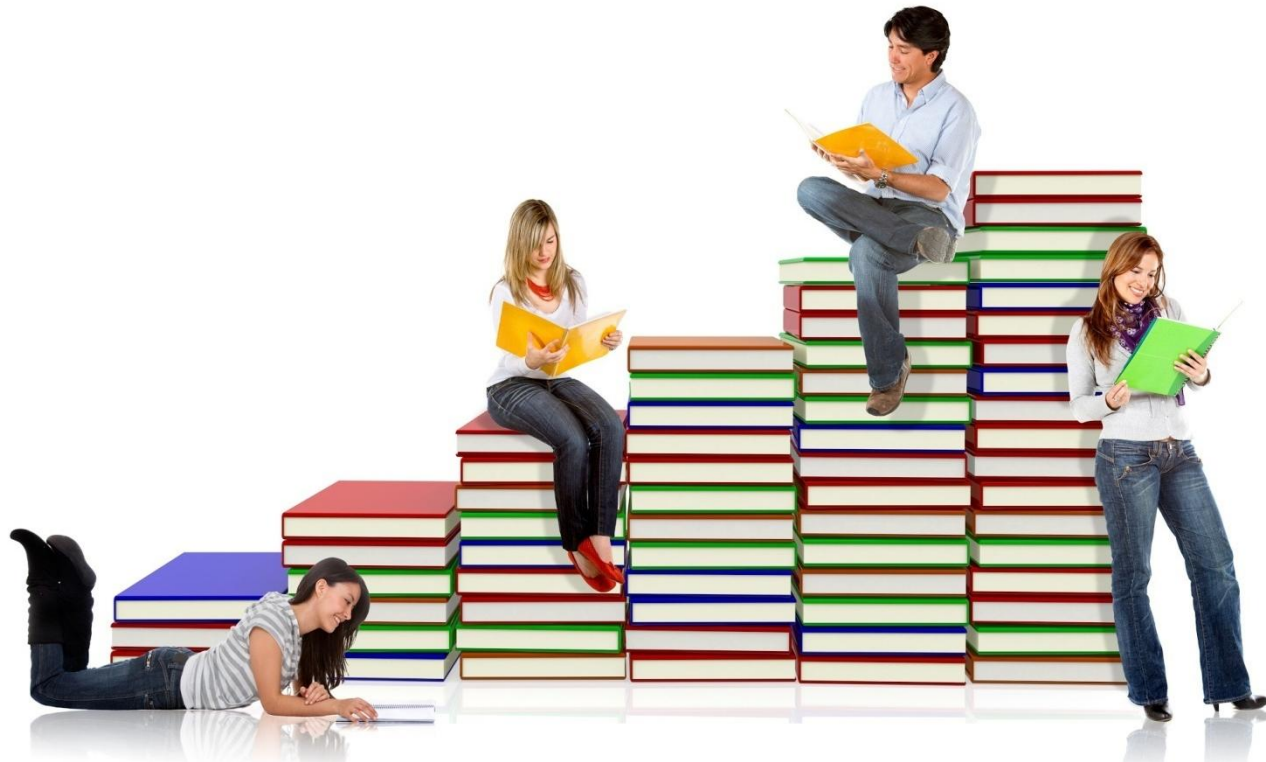
Experience

Education is commonly and formally divided into stages such as preschool, primary school, secondary school and then college, university or apprenticeship.



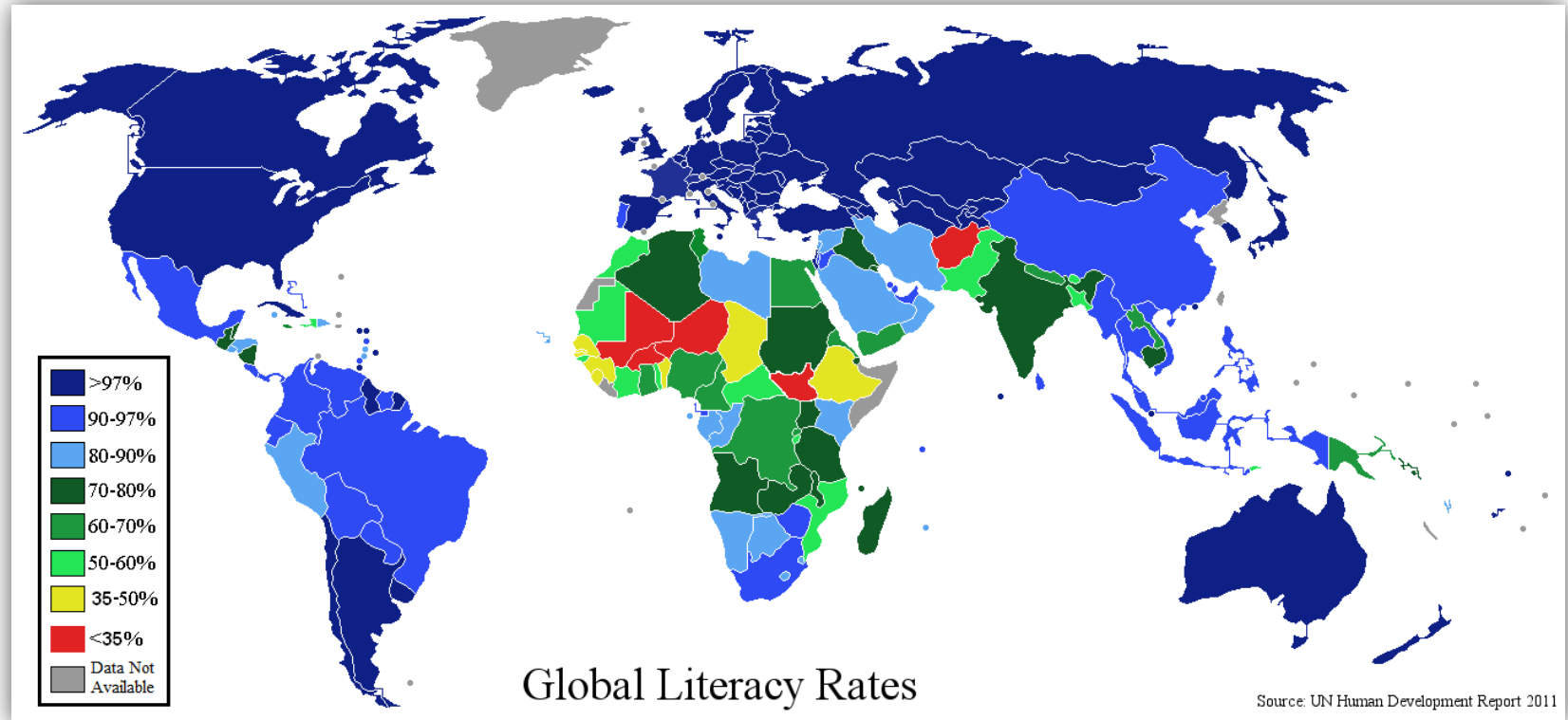
A right to education

A right to education has been recognized by some governments.

At the global level, Article 13 of the United Nations' 1966 International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights recognizes the right of everyone to an education.
