Art Nouveau is an international style of art, architecture, and applied art that was most popular between 1890 and 1910. It was inspired by natural forms and structures, not only in flowers and plants but also in _____(1). Architects tried to harmonize with the natural environment. Art Nouveau is considered a "total" art style, embracing architecture, graphic art, interior design, and most of the decorative arts including jewelry, furniture, textiles, household silver, and other utensils, and lighting, as well as the fine arts. According to the philosophy of the style, art should be a way of life. Art Nouveau designs often use long, _____(2), organic lines, frequently depicting flowers, plants, or other nature-inspired motives. The movement was committed to _____(3) the traditional hierarchy of the arts, which viewed so-called liberal arts, such as painting and sculpture, as superior to craft-based decorative arts;

it also sought to reunite all the arts in service to society. It was in this climate of anti-scholastic sentiment that the major figures of Art Nouveau began to emerge. In France, Hector Guimard produced his Art Nouveau designs for the Paris Métro, while Eugène Grasset created the _____(4) image of the club singer Yvette Guilbert. In Spain, Antoni Gaudí's architecture _____(5) a sense of surrealism, while in Vienna, Gustav Klimt painted the _____(6) portrait of Adele Bloch-Bauer. In the world of design, the Austrian artist Koloman Moser became a crucial figure in the Wiener Werkstätte (Vienna Workshop), a collective of artisans who sought to _____(7) the boundaries between the fine and applied arts. His textile designs were particularly influential, as was his belief that good design should be accessible to all. Moser's approach was echoed in the rise of Art Nouveau in America, where Louis Comfort Tiffany's lamps and stained glass windows brought the movement to a wider audience. In his hands, everyday objects became works of art, but without the _____(8) and _____(9) that had characterized earlier crafts movements. The same spirit of simplicity and functionality was embraced by Charles Rennie Mackintosh in Glasgow, whose designs _____(10) the straight lines of the Scottish tradition alongside floral motives. In France, meanwhile, the Art Nouveau style was being challenged by the rise of new movements such as Cubism, which sought to break down the world into its constituent parts. While Art Nouveau would eventually fall out of _____(11), its influence can still be seen today in the organic forms and flowing lines of architecture and design.
