- 1. Write an **outline** (up to 6 points) of your blog.
- 2. Which tool will you use at various stages of writing a blog / (proofing, paraphrasing, citation tools, AI brainstorming)?

Short Analytical Report

Write a report (approx. 150–200 words): "The Role of Artificial Intelligence in Enhancing Academic Writing and Learning: Opportunities and Challenges"
Requirements

- Academic register
- 1-2 examples of using digital tools (ChatGPT, Grammarly, AI citation tools)
- Clear structure: thesis + evidence
- Conclusion with the stance (*I argue that...*)

Peer Review with AI-Support

Exchange texts in pairs.

Use Grammarly / Hemingway / ChatGPT only as a style editor (not as a generator).

Correct **3 types of errors** and provide **2 recommendations** regarding structure and argumentation
